

# PUBLIC NOTICE

## Are you being approached by surveyors?



GreenView Pipeline LLC, a subsidiary of Tallgrass Energy, is continuing to conduct surveying on lands within these thirteen (13) chapters: **Cameron, Tuba City, Coalmine, Tonalea, Shonto, Kayenta, Dennehotso, Mexican Water, Sweet Water, Red Mesa, Teec Nos Pos, Gadii’ahi, and Hogback.**

The Navajo Nation General Land Development Department approved surveying on August 24, 2023, despite 9 of the 13 Chapters passing resolutions opposing the project.

### **What to do if approached by people claiming to represent the hydrogen project:**

1. The Navajo Nation Land Department has indicated that if representatives from GreenView or Tallgrass are alone and soliciting for grazing permits or speaking to the public in a negative manner. **Please document the interaction** and send to the Navajo Nation General Land Development Department email at: [glddprojects@navajo-nsn.gov](mailto:glddprojects@navajo-nsn.gov)
2. Representatives of GreenView Pipeline LLC or Tallgrass Energy may approach residents within the 13 chapters and may ask for a waiver of grazing permits. In the case of a permit holder waiving their permit, it is protocol for your local Grazing Official and a representative from the Navajo Nation Land Department to be present. The terms of the waiver should be fully and clearly translated and understood by the Permittee. **Remember you have every right to refuse to sign these waivers.**
3. If you feel harassed, threatened, or coerced **call the Navajo Nation Police Department for assistance and file a report at the contact information below:**
